



You Are Invited To the 16th Annual Children's Culture Parade!

Evergreen and Vancouver classes are participating in a celebration of culture by organizing a parade. We have worked hard to prepare displays and banners to honor the diversity of culture in our community.

When: Friday, May 19, 2017

Where: Fort Vancouver Historic Reserve (near 5th & Reserve Streets)

Best viewing is in the meadow south of Officer's Row and north of the Pearson Air Museum.

Time: 10:15 am – 11:30 am

You may park near Officer's Row, at the former Fort Vancouver Library, or near the Fort Vancouver Historic Reserve on residential streets. This year we have additional parking at the Visitor's Center and next to Fort Vancouver in the grassy area, but during the parade you can only access these parking lots on the west side from Fort Vancouver Way, and you must park by 9:30 am and can't leave until 11:40 am after the children leave.

Our parade will feature over 1000 students from Evergreen and Vancouver schools. Vancouver Mayor Tim Leavitt, and Vancouver & Evergreen Superintendents, and other community leaders will attend. You will have free admission into the fort for the program (and the day), but keep in mind that your child needs to stay with their class. We hope to see you there!
